
## Obsidian® ASG Application Guide

## **SEALING I HEALING I REGENERATION**


The correct sequence of application of Obsidian® ASG is shown in the steps below.



Step 1
Resection of the colon with stapler or by another standardized surgical procedure.




Step 2
After successful placement of the anvil and insertion of the circular stapler connect the two parts.



Step 3
Check position of proximal colon and apply at least 2 ml of Obsidian® ASG over entire surface of distal colon stump. Important: Especially the outer edges must be completely covered.



Step 4
The stapler is closed and triggered according to the manufacturer's guidelines and carefully retracted transanally.




Step 5
Air tightness of the anastomosis is controlled by "bubble test - water and air", or by a contrast agent test.



Step 6
After NaCl evacuation and adequate visualization of anastomotic area, reinforce anastomosis completely circumferentially by applying Obsidian® ASG 1.5 cm distal and 1.5 cm proximal.



Step 7
After fascial closure of the abdominal midline during laparoscopic procedures or the entire surgical incision in open procedures apply the remaining Obsidian® ASG directly on top of the fascial closure.



**Step 8** Final wound closure.

<u>Note:</u> After completing application of Obsidian® ASG wait approximately 30 seconds before continuing surgical maneuvers until the polymerization process of the Obsidian® ASG is complete.
